INSTRU	CTIONS.

- 1. Annual Drill.—The Pay and Allowances are to be charged in this Pay-list according to the several Orders and Regulations governing the Annual Drill for the year.
- 2. In all cases of a Militiaman signing the Pay-list for another as his Proxy, a written proxy from the Militiaman authorizing the other to sign for him must be attached to the Pay-list; and in cases where neither the signature of the Militiaman nor his Proxy can be procured, the amount must be deducted from the Pay-list. It will be the special duty of the District Paymaster to see that this order is carried out in all cases before issuing the amount of the Pay-list.
 - 3. No Brigade Staff Officer can, under any circumstances, receive pay, unless he has been regularly gazetted to the Brigade.
 - 4. The Pay-lists must be signed in duplicate by every person included therein for pay before they are sent to the District Paymaster, to be forwarded to the Department, at Ottawa, with the Account Current.
 - 5. The name of every person on the Pay-list shall be called out by the Paymaster together with the amount due to him, and each person shall answer by passing the Paymaster as his name is called.
