THE FENIAN RAID VOLUNTEER BOUNTY ACT.

APPLICATION FOR GRANT.

do hereby apply for a grant under the provisions of The Fenian Raid Volunteer Bounty Act.

The grounds of my application are as follows:—

I was enrolled in the Grimsby Troop Cavalry Corps No 100
and served with it at St Catharines and other points in the Province of
Ontario from End of May
to June in the year 1866.

I was awarded and am now in possession of the Canada General Service Medal for said service.

I have not previously made any application for a grant under the said Bounty Act.
